



## INVESTIGATIONS OFFICER (Occupational Health and Safety)

Reporting to the director of the chief compliance office, the incumbent will conduct investigations of workplace fatalities and serious incidents, and prepare comprehensive reports of the findings. The successful candidate will be required to present the findings to various WorkSafeNB committees, and may be required to provide expert witness testimony to the courts during coroner inquests. The successful applicant will be designated as a health and safety officer, requiring the candidate to be prepared to provide expertise in applying relevant sections of the *Occupational Health and Safety Act* and the Regulation.

The applicant should have a university degree in a related discipline, combined with five years of relevant work experience, including experience in health & safety and investigation processes. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered. The candidate must be able to function within MS Office software, particularly MS Word & Adobe Acrobat and be able to travel extensively. The applicant must hold a professional health and safety related designation, such as CRSP, ROH, CIH or CSP, or be eligible for certification and willing to commit to completing all certification requirements within 24 months of the start date.
