## Parents/Guardians

Talk to your children about workplace safety before Take Our Kids to Work™ day. Ensure they know the risks and are prepared.

Demonstrate safety practices while on the job. Be a good role model.

Supervise students closely during the day. Correct unsafe behaviours immediately.

Ask students if they have any safety concerns.
