LOCK OUT!

The bottom line before working on or cleaning any equipment or machine:

Lock – Tag – Test! General Regulation 91-191, sections 239 and 287

Steps



Turn off the equipment or machine at the operator's control panel.



Install the lock. Remember: one key per lock per worker!



- Attach the tag that identifies you, when you locked out and warning not to operate.
- De-energize the equipment or machine. 4 Careful, all types of energy must be released and locked out where needed.
