List all contracts awarded to individuals or companies (excluding HST). WorkSafeNB will calculate the assessable earnings using the following formulas:

1. Labour - 100% of contract value. No allowance is made for supplies or tools of the trade.
2. Janitorial Service - 80% of contract value.
3. Labour and Materials - 50% of contract value.
4. Courier/Mail Service - 40% of contract value.
5. Hired Equipment - 25% of contract value if supplying equipment with operator such as trucks, tractors, bulldozers, backhoes, and similar equipment. Not to exceed the yearly maximum of \$69,200 for 2022 and \$74,800 for 2023 for each worker/operator.

Contractors and subcontractors who are not individually registered with WorkSafeNB are considered to be workers of the principal, for WorkSafeNB purposes. You may charge the labour and materials, hired equipment, courier/mail service, and janitorial contractors their portion of the assessment. **Labour only contracts cannot be charged back.**
