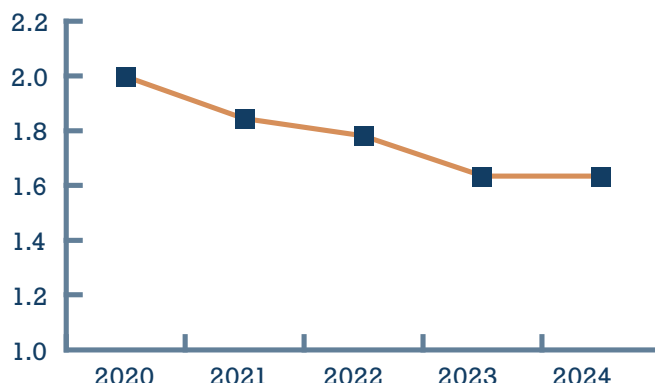

### Common Injuries

#### Injury Types:

Sprains, strains, tears	<b>48%</b>
Cuts or bruises	<b>9%</b>
Fractures	<b>8%</b>

#### Causes:

Bodily reaction or exertion	<b>39%</b>
Slip, trip or fall	<b>17%</b>
Struck by or against object	<b>15%</b>

#### Parts of the body:

Back	<b>18%</b>
Shoulder	<b>10%</b>
Legs	<b>9%</b>

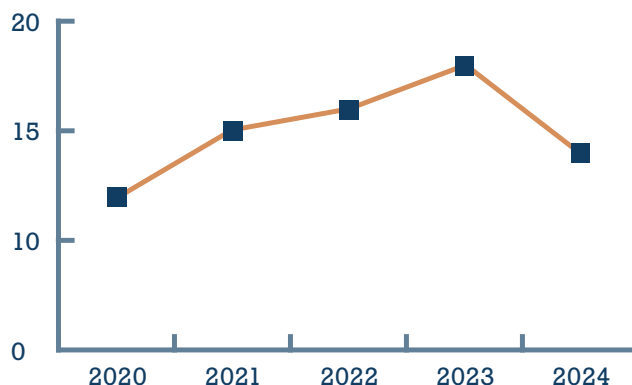
